### **Director Message:**

Dear Students,

India is passing through a phase of 'epidemiological transition'. There is an increasing trend in communicable and non-communicable diseases. Also, there has been a significant shift from hospital-care to community or home-based care due to economic reasons. Hence, the need for having human-resource trained in health-related courses like nursing, health care attendant, OT attendant, ambulance attendant and so on to adequately support medicos and paramedics has been realized.

### **ABOUT US**

SCL Paramedical Council of India, established in the year 2019, is a registered Organization under I.T. Act 2013 and I.R. Act 1908, with its central office located at Uttar Pradesh. The Council registers qualified paramedics or colleges autonomously without any Governmental or non-Governmental association. There is no Act or Council to regulate the hiring or functioning of paramedics, whether in the city or country. There is no way of ascertaining the work record or conduct of a particular paramedic," the official noted. The Council will accredit operation theatre (OT) technicians, OT assistants, Physiotherapy Technician, laboratory technicians, laboratory assistants, X-Ray technicians, ECG technicians, darkroom assistants and Central Sterilisation Department assistants. All institutions will have to register with the Council that will issue certificates only after professionals have worked for fixed period. The council has separate guidelines and regulations issued with the acceptance of all the active members of the governing body of the Council. The Council registers qualified personnel and Colleges/ University for paramedical sciences for world-class training and future practice of the profession. With the limited number of available trained paramedics, the Council aims to minimize the dearth with qualified and trained personnel and compensate the shortage.

### **Mission**

The Health Education and SCL Paramedical Council of India with its central office in Uttar Pradesh was established under Article 29 and 30 (1) of Constitution of India and incorporated under The Legislation of Government of India with an aim to minimize shortfall in trained and qualified paramedics.
